Incorporated in 1918 with just 100 residents, the Village of Nobleford, 20 minutes N.W. of Lethbridge, is a community that gained world wide recognition for the NOBLE BLADE invented by Charles Noble. The Nobleford area Museum has dedicated the majority of its displays to the famed Noble agricultural inventions.

Nobleford's recent growth and vitality is a testament to the fortitude of the village's early settlers, many of which were Dutch immigrants that came to the area to farm the land. In the past 10 years Nobleford has over doubled in land size and population has doubled to near 1200, with strong industrial and residential growth along with exceptional recreation facilities. There are now over 200 job opportunities within Nobleford and over 400 homes. Nobleford adds at least one new recreation attraction each year. Be sure to take a stroll on the paved pathway system, scale the Rubie Park Climbing wall, spin on the Apollo in Centennial Park or enjoy the refreshing Water Spray Park. Just a few kilometers north of town lies Keho Lake, one of the largest water bodies in southern Alberta and is home to a range of great activities, from windsurfing, kite-boarding, boating, bird watching, hunting, year-round fishing, camping and Keho golf course. Keho is home to many windsurfing speed trials (72.6 km) and claims many North American and Canadian speed records. Keho also boasts some Alberta fishing records as well.

Starting in 2004 Nobleford has seen a rebirth of prosperity with an increase in municipal services, property taxes reduced by 80%, assessed value has increase from 20 million to 110 million. In 2008 Nobleford received a MUNICIPAL EXCELLENCE AWARD from the Province of Alberta for is extraordinary achievements. Through successful Investment and business attraction, Nobleford is not only a modern sustainable community, but prosperous.

2018 marks 100 years for Nobleford and plans are in place for celebration including a Municipal TAX FREE year to all Residential home owners.
