Effective immediately, the Village of Nobleford require all businesses, including home businesses, to register for a business license but with no fee required for 2016, and they will receive a license certificate as well as be added to the business list on the website with potential for enhanced services. <http://nobleford.ca/> Or contact office to register.

24% penalty on unpaid Taxes and Village bills

Nobleford property taxes were due payable to the Village of Nobleford before August 31.

Any outstanding taxes are subject to a 12% penalty September 1 and 12% again January 1.

If you anticipate not paying your bill on time, meet with the Village administration to discuss options.

SNOW PLOW, SIDEWALKS AND SNOW GARBAGE pick up

TIPS: Shoveling fresh snow before you walk or drive on it is much easier than shoveling and chipping packed snow. The Village snow plow plows main streets and eventually residential streets, please do not shovel snow onto the street or your neighbor's property as the Village snow plow will push it back on to your property. In order to plow the streets as wide as possible you are requested to park your vehicle off streets when snow fall is expected. You, the property owner are advised to keep your sidewalks adjacent to your property clear of snow. As a renter, your landlord may require you to keep the sidewalks clear of snow, refer to your rental lease for responsibilities. In the event that Garbage pickup in alleys ways is not possible, consider placing your Garbage in front of your house for pickup.

CELL PHONE service in Nobleford: if you want better cell phone service in Nobleford, contact your provider and express your concerns. The Village is lobbying for an increase in signal strength in Nobleford and needs you to phone, email, text, or write letters to your provider. It has been noted that a significant number of people are texting while driving through the Nobleford School Zone. **CAUTION**, the fine for texting /phone as a distracted driver, is \$287. Plus demerits in 2016. Nobleford has received \$13,745.00 in revenue from traffic fine so far in 2015.
