Dear property owner and residents of Nobleford.

Please consider this a valid letter, mailed to you, under seal through Canada Postal Service.

-SUMMER FUN has started, 10 to 3pm, Monday to Thursday at Community Complex. FREE

-Upgrades to Centennial Park have begun and parts of this park will be closed until completed for 2018.

-Nobleford Heritage Day is August 5, 2017. Breakfast at the Complex. Parade. Lunch and Music at Fire Hall. Bench fair, Horse rides, Bouncy Inflatables, Music, Supper at the Community Complex.

-October 16, 2017: Civic election. Nomination day for Nobleford Councillors and Palliser Trustees is September 18.

-The donations and volunteers appreciation sign, at the Spray Park, was torn off the washroom wall in May. It would be appreciated if you would come forward and help replace this sign. Talk with the CAO if you would like to help.

-GRASS / Compost (NO BRANCHES): primary dump site is at the Nobleford Waste Transfer Site, on North Railway Avenue, Thursday, Friday and Saturday. The secondary, GRASS disposal site for Nobleford residents on Highway Avenue is only to be used when WTS is closed. Dump grass on north part of the site, dispose all plastic or paper bags in barrels.

-PLEASE place your plastic garbage bags in a garbage can. This reduces animals spreading your garbage

-BURNING. The only open outdoor fire allowed is a camp style fire in a fire ring. You are liable for your fire.

-2017 Property taxes are Due August 31, 2017. Cash, postdated cheques, and online email Interac are accepted.

-Property owners are responsible for caring for alleyway, lane, and boulevard adjacent to your property.

-PLEASE "NO PETS" in the SPRAY PARK. **\$100 fine.**

CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR PET or \$100 fine.

-Owners of unlicensed dogs and cats will be **fined \$100.**

Unlicensed animals may be removed from the Village.

-The Village is seeking one citizen to attend Alberta Emergency Alert training in September and serve the Village in a volunteer capacity in warning the public of potential emergencies. Honorarium will be paid.

-Please notify the Village if your sewer is backed up. The Village offers emergency sewer line cleaning for \$40 if it can be scheduled during regular working hours and \$100 after hours if staff is available.

Nobleford Business "Mulder Plumbing and Heating" offers after-hours sewer line cleaning for \$150/hr. 403-795-7582

-Please call 911 if you see suspicious activity, collect identification such as description of person, vehicle, license.

-Railway Avenue sewer line replacement/road reconstruction is complete; \$300,000 Village, \$500,000 province.

-Nobleford shall receive a 2 million dollar provincial grant for a 3 million dollar wastewater lagoon upgrade project.

-Alberta Transportation will be upgrading Highway #519 and the intersection onto Highway Avenue, Nobleford.

-Do not flush fabric wipes in toilets as they plug the underground sewage system and costs you, the Village, about \$400 each time a hydra power flush truck and crew is required. Recently Hunt Street sewer main was backed up from wipes.

-Watch the next newsletter for information on Noble Central School's Grand Reopening.

-Standard First Aide Course available July 20 & 21 at Nobleford Community Complex. Cost is \$100 or \$80 corporate rate. Contact Tanisha, 587-787-1659.
