
## Dear Nobleford property owner.

Please consider this a valid letter, mailed to you, under seal through Canada Postal Service.

- AXIA/NCCS free Movie in the Park will be September 15<sup>th</sup> at the Community Complex, showing "Cars 3".
  - Nomination Day for Nobleford Councillors and Palliser Trustees is September 18. Election Day is October 16, 2017.
  - HUNT STREET: Recently Hunt Street sewer main was backed up from rag wipes and clearing it cost \$400. Do not flush fabric wipes in toilets as they plug the underground sewage system and costs you, the Village.
  - RUBIE CRESCENT: The Village has spent near \$1000 on 2 occasions for flushing and clearing large rocks that someone intentionally placed in the storm drain and toy Frisbees that blocked the drain causing flooding.
  - Village dump truck for rent at \$40 per load for tree branches. No charge for tree trimming on boulevard.
  - PLEASE place your plastic garbage bags in a garbage can. **This reduces animals spreading your garbage**
  - Property owners are responsible for caring for alleyway, lane, and boulevard adjacent to your property.
  - GRASS / Compost (NO BRANCHES): primary dump site is at the Nobleford Waste Transfer Site, on North Railway Avenue, Thursday, Friday and Saturday. The secondary, GRASS disposal site for Nobleford residents on Highway Avenue is only to be used when WTS is closed. Dump grass on north part of the site, dispose all plastic or paper bags in barrels.
  - PLEASE **"NO PETS"** in the SPRAY PARK. **\$100 fine.** CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR PET or \$100 fine.  
Owners of unlicensed dogs and cats will be **fined \$100.** Unlicensed animals may be removed from the Village.
  - Please notify the Village if your sewer is backed up. The Village offers emergency cleaning for \$40 during regular working hours. Nobleford Business "Mulder Plumbing and Heating" \$150/hr. 403-795-7582 and Mr. Rooter: 403-715-1517
  - Please call 911 if you see suspicious activity; collect identification such as description of person, vehicle, and license.
  - Congratulations to all for the Nobleford SUMMER FUN program that saw 644 user days this summer.
  - \$150,000 Upgrades to Centennial Park continue; you can still donate to the project, 403-824-3460 for info. \$50,000 from Nobleford Parks and Recreation Society fundraising, \$50,000 in grants, \$50,000 from Village of Nobleford policy #02-22.
  - Nobleford Community Complex exterior paint and new ceiling tile inside gym are done and interior paint, acoustic panels, and locks are scheduled for this fall. Funding provided by Province of Alberta CFEP \$23,616, Lethbridge County \$9000, NCCS \$500, and Village of Nobleford \$9500 (policy #02-22).
  - Spray Park will be open until mid-September, weather permitting.
  - CONTRACT #1, TENDER OFFERING: PREPARATION and PAINTING, interior of Community Complex: lower 8-10 ft portion of auditorium, entry ways, of approximately 3800 square foot. Drywall patch work, clean, and 2 coats of paint.
  - CONTRACT #2, PAINT materials.
  - There is still a Fire Ban in effect. Nobleford adheres to Lethbridge County fire bans so check their website for updates.
  - Video surveillance of various Nobleford streets and public locations will begin this fall.
- TRAFFIC BYLAW #644**
- If your vehicle, including RV, is longer than 8 m (26 feet), it cannot be parked on the street without a Village permit.
  - Trailers, including RVs, are allowed to park on streets no longer than 72 hours in a 120 hour period and must be hitched.
  - Semis and School Buses are **NOT** allowed to be parked on streets or private property unless issued a Village permit.
