Residential Phase 5 Centennial Subdivision (38 lots) is under construction. Nobleford has signed an access agreement with AXIA communications to pursue installation of **fiber optic lines** to all of Nobleford. The over 1 million dollar estimated cost will be paid by AXIA providing sufficient interest is expressed from Nobleford residents.

The realization of fiber optic in Nobleford will allow for better internet that is comparable to or better than major cities.
