#04-09 PRIORITY, SNOW PLOWING PROCEDURE IN NOBLEFORD.

- 1- Snow plow shall be in a state of operation at all times between Nov 1 and April 30. Fueled up, good battery, plow on front, sander operational. Sand will be loaded at discretion of PWF or operator.
- 2- Skid steer shall be operational at all times and with good battery fueled up in anticipation of use.
- 3- Toro mower tractor shall be in a state of snow plow operation at all times between Nov 1 and March 31, with good battery, fueled up, and available to convert to plow use at discretion of PWF in other months in anticipation of snow fall.
- 4- All equipment shall be located appropriately so it will start in cold weather.
- 5- The Village administration and Public works staff have agreed to a discretionary work day start time relative to weather conditions and work load. An example of this is start work times are often 7 am in the summer months. In anticipation of snow fall using weather forecast or other, the PWF will himself or direct public works staff to start work earlier than the usual 8 am or 7 am.
Any start time before 7:00 am is subject to overtime rate of pay, or time in lieu or workday schedule adjustment.
- 6- On snow days it is a PRIORITY that the Snow plow be on the Nobleford streets within 10 minutes of starting time of workday, and that other snow removal equipment and manpower be on the roads ASAP.
- 7- The order of plowing road will be as follows
 - a. Highway avenue
 - b. King street and Fire Hall
 - c. Railway avenue,
 - d. Barons street
 - e. Centennial Avenue
 - f. ALL other streets*The Village policy does not include plowing snow in Alleys and lane ways unless for service vehicle access.*
- 8- Sidewalk plowing
 - a. Centennial Park along highway ave and School
 - b. Both sides of king street, fire hall, and through Centennial Park.
 - c. Walking path, Kenex and behind Rubie and along Railway Avenue

Any other side walk plowing shall be at the discretion of PWF on a priority basis
