## **You Are Illegally Parked** - this is a warning -

**PARKING NOTICE** - Please be considerate of your neighbors and community.

**Future Tickets with fines may be issued under the Alberta and Nobleford laws by the RCMP or Village for violations; vehicles will be towed without notice.**

- NO PARKING on HIGHWAY AVENUE at any time.
- NO PARKING in alleys or lanes.
- NO PARKING in front of driveways, or dead end roads or lanes, or in front of fire hydrants.
- NO SEMI PARKING in Nobleford except on the **west side of Railway Avenue**.
- NO TRAILER PARKING in residential Nobleford.
  - The provincial laws do allow for trailer parking on streets providing the trailer is hitched to the vehicle at all times, **but** the Village law prohibits trailer parking on streets. DO NOT park any trailer on any residential street for more than short periods of time for loading or unloading unless you have permission from the Village.
  - Phone the Village office: 403-824-3555, to request parking permission.

*Village Bylaw: No person shall park any commercial vehicle, bus or motor home, truck, engine, trailer or truck of the design capacity of more than **1 tone or a length of more than 6 metres** on any highway other than the designated truck route, except where such parking is expressly prohibited on truck route.*

- You may park a semi-tractor, bus or RV on your private property. **Your property line is not your sidewalk**. Property line is generally 1 to 3 meters, or more, back from the sidewalk.
  - You shall be responsible for costs to repair any damage that vehicles cause to public property including concrete sidewalks, pavement, hydrants.
  - You shall be aware that a semi / truck on your property is subject to the noise bylaw and should not be running during the quiet time of 10 pm to 7 am.
- Visitors may park their RV on the east side of the community complex for up to 72 hours. *There are 15 amp electrical outlets available for light electrical use “NOT AIR CONDITIONING”, if your RV is not self-contained. An RV sewage dump, water fill, site is available on 12<sup>th</sup> Street and 14<sup>th</sup> Street. Donations are accepted at the Village office.*
