

Seniors Property Tax Deferral Program

The Seniors Property Tax Deferral program allows eligible senior homeowners to defer all or part of their property taxes through a low-interest home equity loan from the Alberta government. If you qualify, the Alberta government will pay all or part of your property taxes on your behalf through a low-interest loan that is secured against your home equity. You then repay the loan with interest when you sell your house, are no longer eligible, or at any time you choose. The Seniors Property Tax Deferral program is voluntary and homeowners must apply.

Eligibility

To be eligible for the Seniors Property Tax Deferral program, you must:

- be an Alberta resident (65 or older);
- own a residential property in Alberta; and
- have a minimum of 25% equity in your home.
