Every day we will have new events taking place. At least twice a week, we will try to go to the spray park (weather permitting) where we will focus on road safety and community involvement, with normal pickup at the Complex. We will take part in the Heritage Day Parade (Aug 5th) and have a few special presentations. This is an excellent program for kids to make new friends while having a fun and safe summer!

Children should bring with them lunch and snacks, water, a hat, bug spray, and a bathing suit and towels for when we go to the spray park. Children are more than welcome to ride bikes and park them outside the complex and to go home for lunch. Pick up/home time is right at 3:00 pm. A later morning drop off is acceptable but please let us know in advance. Parents/older siblings are more than welcome to volunteer for a day or to bring treats for the children. All volunteers must register with the Village office.

Parents/Guardians must register their children on the first day they come in. Early registration is available at the Village Office.
